FREE TRANSPORTATION TO THE MARYLAND ZOO FROM THE INNER HARBOR - SATURDAYS IN JULY AND AUGUST

BALTIMORE, MD – The Maryland Zoo in Baltimore and Veolia Transportation are bringing the Safari Express shuttle to Baltimore's Inner Harbor once again this summer! Beginning on Saturday, July 5 and continuing each Saturday through August 30, Zoo visitors can ride this free shuttle from the Baltimore Visitor Center at the Inner Harbor to The Maryland Zoo in Baltimore and back.

The Safari Express will leave from the Baltimore Visitor Center and take visitors to the Zoo, then return visitors to the Harbor later in the day. Shuttle times are as follows:

9:30 am, 10:00 am, 10:30 am, 11:00 am, 12:00 pm, 1:00 pm, 2:00 pm

Zoo to Baltimore Visitor Center

11:30 am, 12:30 pm, 1:30 pm, 2:30 pm, 3:30 pm, 4:30 pm

The shuttle is available to anyone who wants to visit the Zoo - out-of-town visitors, families, Zoo members - anyone who is looking for a fast and easy way to get to the Zoo.
