JONES FALLS ZEPHYR TRAIN RIDE (\$)

Board the Zoo's passenger train and enjoy a leisurely 10-minute ride along the forested edge of the *African Journey* exhibit before looping back along the same track. Open daily, weather permitting.



CAROUSEL (\$)

Experience the fun of an old-fashioned carousel ride with a Zoo twist. Our Victorian-style carousel features thirty unique and exquisitely designed animals. Choose your favorite! Open daily, weather permitting.



FEED A GIRAFFE (\$)

Visit the Giraffe Feeding Station and let a giraffe pull a leafy snack straight from your hand. Incredible! (Weather permitting.)



PENGUIN ENCOUNTER (\$)

Meet penguins up close. Enjoy a 20-minute tour of the Zoo's Penguin Embassy. Tours happen twice daily and can be purchased at the main entrance. Limited space available.
