Amazing Adaptations

Recommended for: Grades 1-3

How do animals use their senses to explore the world? What unique physical traits help them survive and thrive? Discover the answers in our Amazing Adaptations program! Through hands-on activities, interactive games, visits from animal ambassadors, an exciting night hike, and more, participants will explore the fascinating—and sometimes astonishing—adaptations found throughout the animal kingdom.

Habitat Investigators

Recommended for: Grades 4-6

From scorching deserts to icy tundras, animals survive in an amazing variety of habitats. Investigate the diverse places animals call home and discover the remarkable adaptations that help them find everything they need to survive. Participants will engage in games, hands-on activities, visits from animal ambassadors, an adventurous night hike, and more as they explore the basic ingredients all living things need to survive!

Zoo Keepers after Dark

Recommended for: Grades 6-12

Zoo Keepers are the dedicated staff members who work closely with our animals—but did you know there's much more to the role than just interacting with animals? Join us for this engaging program as we explore the many responsibilities of Zoo Keeping, from habitat cleaning and diet preparation to enrichment and daily training. Through interactive games, hands-on activities, visits from animal ambassadors, an educational night hike, and more, participants will discover the world of Zoo Keeping and gain a deeper understanding of what it takes to care for animals each day.

Conservation Adventures

Recommended for: Grades 6-12

While many animals are facing the threat of extinction, The Maryland Zoo and citizens (like you!) around the world are working to save wildlife and protect wildplaces. Explore the variety of challenges that animals face and learn about the conservation efforts and successes happening around the globe to protect these species for future generations. Through interactive games, hands-on activities, visits from animal ambassadors, an educational night hike, and more, participants will learn how they can use their voices to advocate for animals.
